## Instructions for Abstract Submission

### THIRD ANNUAL CONFERENCE ON VACCINE RESEARCH

**1. Language.** All abstracts must be submitted in English.

**2. Subject Matter.** The Scientific Program Committee invites abstracts on basic research, applied research and development, pre-clinical studies, clinical studies, and field trials on vaccines. Abstracts pertaining to subject matter areas shown on the abstract form are encouraged. Other abstracts relevant to vaccine research and development from fields such as microbiology, immunology, epidemiology, and molecular biology are also welcome.

**3. Abstract Format.** Abstracts should include title, author(s) and affiliation(s) (use asterisk to indicate presenting author), objective, methods, results, and conclusions. Abstracts should be typed onto the abstract forms provided, must be legible, single-spaced, and in a font 10 point or larger. Abstracts which are not properly formatted will not be considered. Use the sample abstract as a guide. Please check the appropriate category and format boxes in the left-hand margin of the form.

**4. Rules.** Abstracts should be original and should not have been published or presented at another scientific meeting. However, updated information based on additional data acquired and/or analyzed since a prior presentation is acceptable.

**6. Deadline.** Abstracts must be received by 5 p.m. Eastern time on Friday, January 28, 2000.

**7. Selection.** Abstracts suitable for presentations at the Third Annual Conference on Vaccine Research will be selected by the Abstract Selection Committee.

**8. Notification and Presenter Information.** A properly completed Abstract Acknowledgment Card will be returned to you within two weeks of abstract receipt. Notification of abstract acceptance will be mailed by March 1, 2000. Be sure to complete Abstract Disposition Card.

Information for preparing oral and/or poster presentations will be provided at the time of abstract acceptance. Oral presentations will be 10 minutes, with an additional 5 minutes allotted for questions from the audience. Standard poster boards will be used, measuring 4 feet high by 8 feet wide (1.22 meters high by 2.44 meters wide).

**9. Publication.** Abstracts will be published in the final program book exactly as submitted. Abstracts will also be posted on the Internet. Be sure that all relevant information is included in the abstract box.
